### **GENERAL RULES FOR CONTINUING EDUCATION**

- ⇒ The Colegio de Farmacéuticos reserves the right to cancel any educational activity if the minimum capacity (35 people) is not met in order to offer them.
- ⇒ Cancellations or changes must be made on or 10 days before the educational activity for an 80% refund of the total amount paid. The remaining 20% will be used for clerical expenses.
- ⇒ All participants must go through the registration desk to validate their attendance. The conferences will start on time as per schedule.
- ⇒ Photo ID is required at conference entrance. No participants will be allowed to enter the room 10 to 30 minutes after the conference has started depending on conference duration.
- ⇒ The participant must be present until the end of the conference.
- ⇒ Faculty conflict of interest disclosure must be conveyed to the participants before starting each conference.
- ⇒ With the purpose of making improvements or changes to the continuing education program it is important for participants to fill out the evaluation sheet and deliver it to the facilitator if applicable.
